\*All qualified 4-H & FFA members or the national juniors breed association governing the breed they are entering, are eligible to enter.

\*Out-of-State exhibitors welcome.

\*Barns/fairground will be open on Friday. Overnight tie-outs, stalling/penning & trailer parking welcome.

\*Shavings available for purchase.

\*Wash racks available for all species

#### \*\*"Full Fit" show.

\*No intact male animals will be allowed to show.

\*Judges decisions will be final. Announcements day of show take precedence.

\*Must be at least 3 animals of any breed or will show in AOB class.

\*Exhibitors must show their own animals unassisted unless they have more than one animal in the same class. If the exhibitor has more than 1 animal showing in the same class, another show exhibitor may show the other animal. The owner is required to show the highest placing animal in any championship drive.

\*Space is limited so be prepared to show out of your trailers. Generators are encourages. All exhibitors will be required to keep their stalls clean & to clean area and stalls out after the show.

\*Showmanship age divisions: Senior: 14-19 Inter: 10-13 Junior: 7-9 Novice for under 7.

\*Heifers, Ewes, Gilts, Doe kids can be shown in prospect market and breeding classes providing proper entry & fees are paid.

\*Buckles will be presented to Grand Champions Market & Breeding Goat, Lamb, Swine, and Beef. Showmanship Champion winners in three age divisions.

- Show will begin at 1pm(or 30 min. after the sheep show)
- All goat must be weigh in by 11 am

• Show order: Showmanship, Senior, Intermediate, Junior, and Novice. Goat show & Champion selected. Then Breeding Show & Champion selected.
